NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Banks will be holding a Community Review Meeting to consider Urban Growth Boundary (UGB) alternative maps. This meeting follows an adopted review process that expands the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) grant work effort initiated by the City earlier this year. The City has retained the consulting services of CH2M HILL to perform the expanded project work tasks, including preparation of the UGB alternative maps.

The Community Meeting will allow the City to present updated project information to the public-at-large and provide an opportunity for citizens to ask questions or submit comments about the UGB alternative maps.
