



PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Banks will be holding a community review meeting to continue a public discussion for future Urban Growth Boundary (UGB) expansion. This meeting follows an adopted review process that expands the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) grant work effort initiated by the City over a year ago. The City has retained the consulting services of CH2M HILL to perform the project work tasks.

The purposes of this community review meeting are to:

- Provide a brief history of the project to date.
- Present the consultant/City staff recommendation(s) regarding zoning and get community feedback. Clarify that the zoning alternatives have not yet been considered (or voted on) by City Council.
- Discuss next steps – specifically, that City Council will be deciding on a preferred zoning alternative at a special meeting on May 10. The point of this community meeting is to inform that decision.
