**Approve Tax Rate:**

Michael Nelson made the motion "It is moved that the Budget Committee of the City of Banks approves taxes for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 at the rate of \$1.97 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for operating purposes in the General Fund". Motion was seconded by Brian Biehl and the motion passed unanimously.

Michael Nelson made the motion "It is moved that the Budget Committee of the City of Banks approves taxes for Fiscal Year 2014-2015, at the rate of \$2.35 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for Police Services. Motion was seconded by Mark Gregg and the motion passed unanimously.
