



Annexation

Annexation is a process where a property owner or owners petition to have their land included within the corporate boundaries of the City of Banks. Properties eligible for annexation must be within the City's Urban Growth Boundary (UGB), adjacent to city limits and at a location where urban services can be extended. Property owners may find annexation appropriate to develop urban type land uses on their property and/or when City amenities such as municipal water or sewer service or street maintenance are desired.

How Do I Apply?

An Annexation Application Packet, a Measure 37 Waiver Form and a legal description of the property along with the fee should be submitted to the Community Development Department. A legal description of the property can be obtained from the Washington County Assessor's office. Refer to the Banks Municipal Code Section 30.01 through 30.06 for review process and approval criteria.
