The City of Banks is accepting applications from persons interested in filling position #PC3 on the Banks Planning Commission. The Planning Commission consists of 7 voting members. The Term for Planning Commission Members is 3 years. This opening would be filling the remainder of a current term with an expiration date of December 31, 2017. Voting members at the time of their nomination, appointment, and tenure in office, shall be residents of the City, except that 2 members of the Planning Commission may be persons who reside outside of the City, within the Banks Urban Growth Boundary, or within the Banks Urban Reserve Area. Planning Commission Members shall receive no compensation for their services as Planning Commissioners. The Planning Commission is responsible for making recommendations to the City Council on issues relating to the Comprehensive Plan, Zoning & Planning Ordinances, UGB, Urban Reserve, and other planning issues.
