NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT a **public hearing will be held by the City of Banks Planning Commission at or shortly after 6:30 PM on Monday, November 28, 2022**, to consider whether to recommend adoption of Guidelines to Park and Trail Acquisition, Design, and Development to City Council. This is a public meeting where the Planning Commission will take public testimony, deliberate, and consider a recommendation to City Council.

On **Tuesday, December 13, 2022, at or shortly after 7:00 PM the City Council will hold a public hearing** regarding the Guidelines to Park and Trail Acquisition, Design, and Development after which it may make a final decision. This is a public meeting where the City Council will take public testimony, deliberate, and consider adopting the changes.

A complete copy of the project record, including the guidelines, staff report, findings, and recommendations will be available at City Hall for viewing seven (7) days prior to each public hearing.

Oral or written testimony may be presented at the public hearings. Written comment on the proposal is also welcome prior to the hearings.
